(e) possess a Bachelor's degree in entire Statistics followed by a Post-Graduate Degree in Management or a diploma in Management of an Institute recognised by Government;

(iii) possess academic, administrative or field experience involving statistical work for not less than seven years acquired after obtaining the minimum qualifications referred to in sub-clauses (ii) of a clause (b) of this rule;

Provided that the age-limit may be relaxed in the case of candidates who, in the opinion of the Commission, possess good academic qualifications or experience or both;

Provided further that the condition regarding experience may be relaxed by three years by the Commission in the case of candidates who possess a Doctorate degree in Statistics, Econometrics or Economics in addition to the minimum qualifications referred to in sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) of this rule;

Provided also that the conditions regarding experience may be relaxed in favour of candidates who, in the opinion of the Commission, possess good academic career.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (ii) and (iii) of clause (b) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opi-

(g) "Research Assistant" means a person borne on the cadre of Research Assistant in the Directorate.

3. Appointment to the posts of Research Officer/Statistical Officer/Statistical Officer (Inspection)/ District Statistical Officer/Establishment Officer in the Directorate shall be made either :-

A) by promotion of a suitable person on basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the person holding the post of Research Assistant having a minimum regular continuous service of three years in that post ; or

B) by nomination from amongst candidates who-

i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than thirty years of age ;

ii) (a) possess Master's degree in Statistics, Biometry, Econometrics or Mathematical Economics, or

- (e) Computer programming in cobal, Fortran, etc. and have undergone training in that regards.

4. Appointment to the post either by promotion or by nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 4, if in the opinion of the Government the exigencies of service so require the Government may, in consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the post in relaxation of the ratio prescribed in Rule 4 for appointment by promotion and nomination, the relaxation shall be effective from 1st January, 1986 and thereafter.

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6. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.
